 - Cohort learning and mentorship
 - Building Intersectional Communities and Solidarity: Direct and facilitated access to partners, presenters, landowners, social capital, information and opportunities
 - Train, mentor and hiring cultural artists (elder generation and next generation) to be arts administrators. Investing in young people
 - Giving stipends for their time and seed granting for specific short term projects with long term impacts
