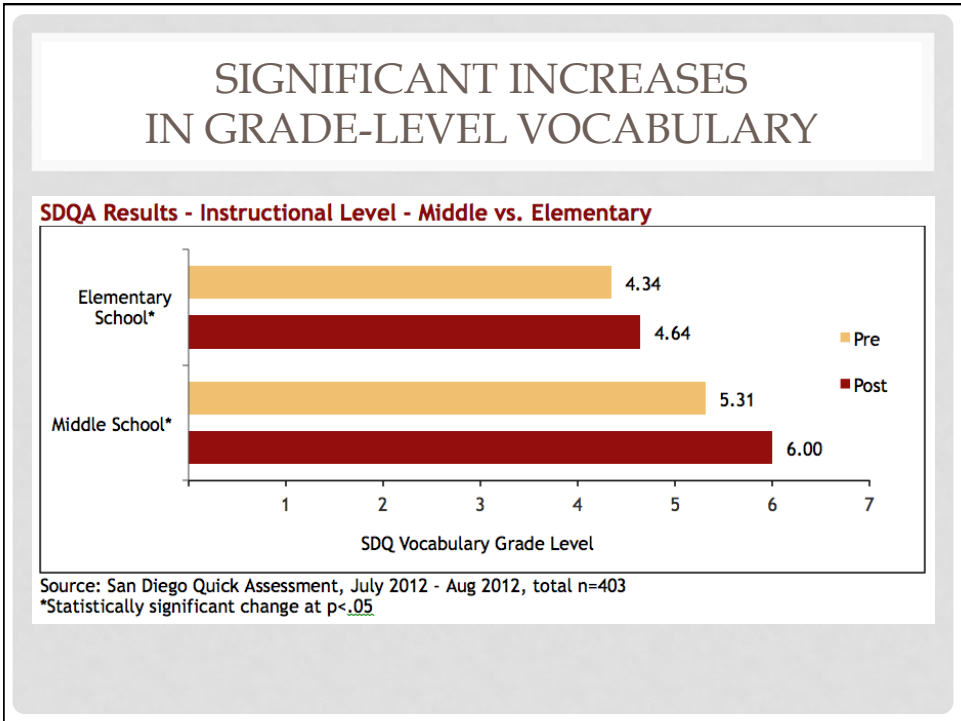
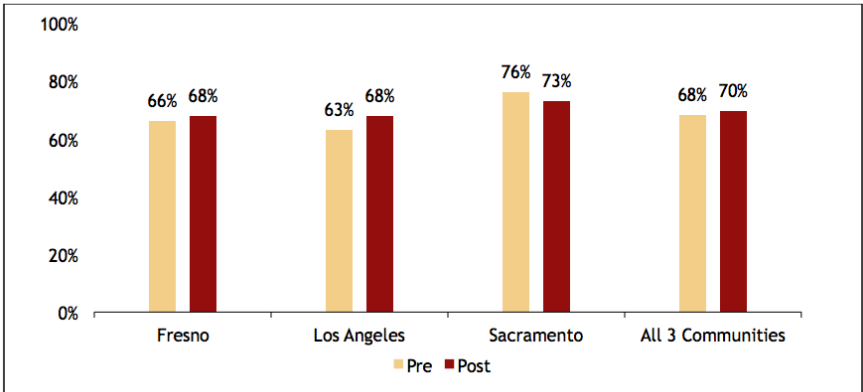

WORK HABITS

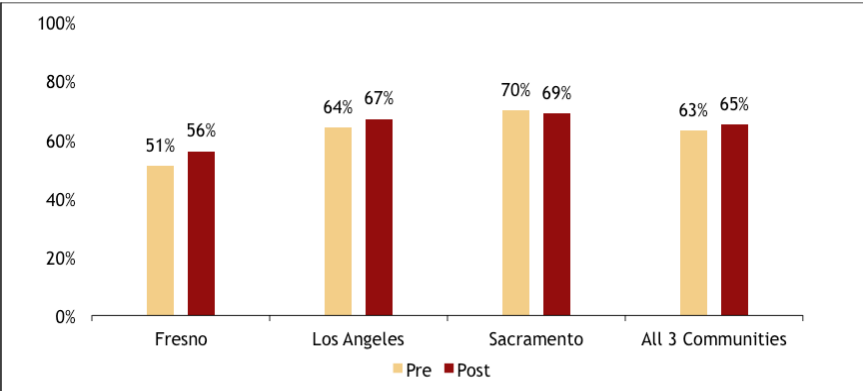
Youth Perception of Work Habits

READING EFFICACY

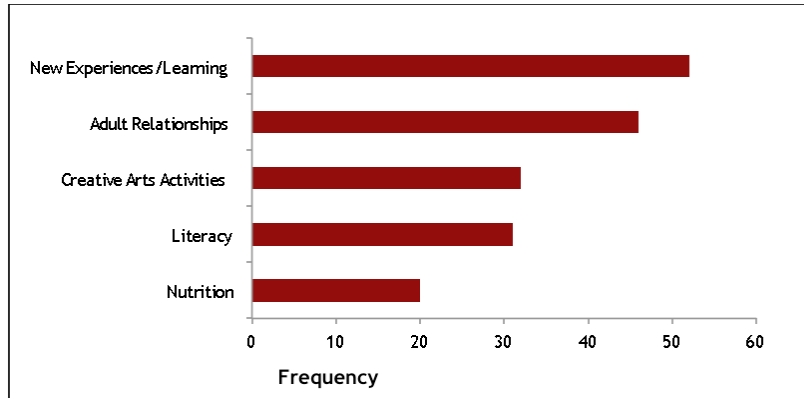
Youth Perception of Reading Efficacy

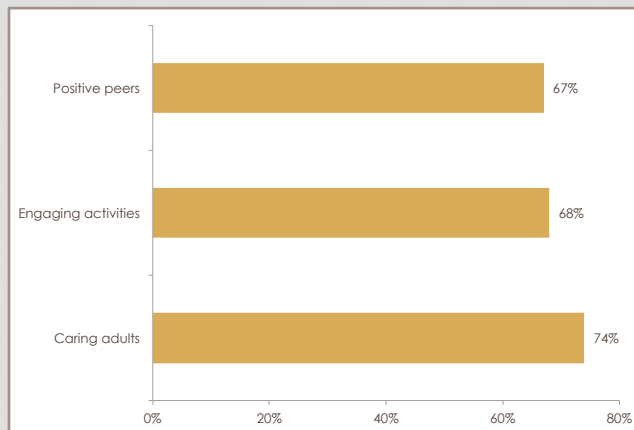

HIGH AND SUSTAINED SCHOOL DAY ATTENDANCE

School Day Attendance, School Year 2011-12 and Fall, 2012-13

Fresno (n=367)	98%	98%	0%
Los Angeles (n=618)	98%	98%	0%
Sacramento (n=324)	97%	98%	+1%*

*Statistically significant change at p<.05

Plus, participants in Fresno 30% less likely to be chronically absent than similar peers!
